UEA wanted to introduce a revenue generating car park to run alongside the existing pass card system that was in operation.

The Organisation

The University of East Anglia (UEA) has more than 9,000 undergraduate students and nearly 4,000 postgraduates studying on campus. UEA is located two miles outside Norwich city centre in 320 acres of parkland.



The Requirement

UEA wanted to introduce a revenue generating car park to run alongside the existing pass card system that was in operation for the university staff and students.

As UEA is situated on a very large campus the parking system had to be split between a Pay-on-Foot system and Pay-and-Display machines.



The Solution

Blick Alfa installed a car parking system using an Easipark Pay-on-Foot system and Vision 3000 Pay-and-Display machines.

As there was no definite specification put forward by UEA, Blick Alfa won the contract as a result of the flexibility shown in providing a solution with regards to the pass card system already in place.

Regular site visits were made prior to, and after, installation so that UEA were fully confident of the solution being put forward by Blick Alfa.
